

POST PROM 2006 RULES AND REGULATIONS

**FRIDAY, MAY 19th - SATURDAY, MAY 20th
COMMUNITY YMCA, RED BANK, NJ**

The Post Prom, sponsored by the HTHS PFA, will be held at the Community YMCA in Red Bank, NJ, immediately following the Junior/Senior Prom. We encourage students and their dates to attend this all-night gala.

In order to make Post Prom a safe, fun event for all who attend, we ask that students and their parents review the following rules and regulations.

All students must be bused to the event. Students who plan to drive to Gibbs Hall will need to make arrangements to have their cars picked up at the site of the prom after 8:00 p.m. No student is permitted to enter the YMCA without arriving on the bus.

No student will be admitted without a signed permission slip. Only HTHS juniors or seniors and their dates are eligible to attend the Post Prom Party. If a student's date is not a HTHS junior or senior student, a second packet of information and permission slips must be downloaded from the HTHS web page under "Events". **All forms must be completed and returned to the PFA mailbox in the main office by May 12th, 2006.**

All bags will be checked, including bags for non-HTHS dates. Bring your items for the Post Prom Party in a sports bag **labeled with your name**. One bag per student plus a blanket or pillow is permitted. Leave your bag before homeroom on Friday, May 19th, in the HTHS Basement Tech lab. Bags will not be accepted after 7:45 am. A female faculty member will check the girls' bags and a male faculty member will check the boys' bags. HTHS PFA will transport all the bags to the YMCA that afternoon.

Students must wear sneakers in the YMCA, and each student should bring a change of clothes, towel, swimsuit, etc. Lockers are available for students for hanging and storing their formal attire. Mats will be available for anyone needing some sleep, and students may want to bring pillows and blankets. HTHS PFA

is providing everything for free; students do not need to bring any money to the YMCA. The YMCA is a smoke-free facility. Students are not permitted to smoke anywhere on the premises.

Students may leave the Post Prom Party only if signed out by a parent/guardian. Anyone who signs out may not return.

Each person attending the party is responsible for their actions. Students are expected to abide by policies governing school functions.

Any student in violation of these policies will be required to leave. Parents will be contacted to pick up their child. If parents are unavailable, police will be notified.

No alcohol, drugs or gambling will be permitted on the premises.

Students must be present to win raffle prizes that will be awarded that night.

It is recommended that students not drive themselves home following the Post Prom Party after they have been up all night. Students may find themselves too tired to drive home safely. When filling out the permission slip please list the person picking up your child and an alternate if desired. If the authorized driver is changed you must submit the change in writing. **If another person is picking your child up without this written change a call will be placed to the parent regardless of the time.** Students should be picked up at the YMCA at 6:00 a.m. Saturday, May 20th. Please be prompt in arriving at the Y. Students not picked up by 6:15 am will become the guest of the Red Bank Police Department.
